

“TV INTERVENTIONS” COMPETITION – 7th EDITION

A *Fundación Rodríguez* project

The " TV Interventions " project puts forward the televisual medium and television on internet as the format for proposals on audiovisual creation and thinking about television language, concentrated doses of an advertising or experimental nature, questioning the media and its message, surprise inserts in programming schedules, on the net and on the screen.

1. The theme.

The overall theme for this, the seventh, edition of " TV Interventions " is: "Television: a public and private space".

2. The pieces.

The audiovisual pieces will have a maximum duration of 2 minutes. In this time you may include as many pieces as you like, although none is to last more than 1 minute.

Only the video version of each piece will have credits while, on the web, the access to the pieces will be through the author's name.

The pieces can be accessed through the web at www.intervenciones.tv. To access the complete selected pieces, it is necessary to request this at info@intervenciones.tv, a download access key. All pieces may be previewed for a few seconds.

The pieces may be original and unedited.

3. Characteristics of the pieces:

- AVI, MOV, WMW, SWF, MPEG formats
- Limit the set of remitted videos to a total of 2 minutes and 5 megas

4. The competition and prizes

The competition is mixed. *Fundación Rodríguez* invites 4 artists to participate who choose four authors from amongst those entered for the open competition.

The invited artists will receive 500 euros (plus 350 euros more for the task of serving on the selection panel).

The authors selected in the competition will receive 500 euros each.

The choice of an author will be made by means of a "popular vote" and will receive an award of 500 euros.

Voting on www.intervenciones.tv from 15 to 24 May.

5. Entries for the competition and closing date:

6. Vitoria-Gasteiz City Council

Vitoria-Gasteiz City Council will receive a direct copy of the master and this will form part of the Media Library collection of the Montehermoso Arts and Culture Centre and will be available to be visualised within its installations or at the network of municipal libraries. Vitoria-Gasteiz City Council may make successive copies, with the same or with other format, for the internal use of the Media Library, as dictated by physical wear and tear and potential loss of data.

Vitoria-Gasteiz City Council will also have at its disposal and, in line with the criteria of the artist of an excerpt (*extracto*), a maximum of 20 seconds and a photo still for our image data bank that is to be used solely for information and documentary purposes, to be consulted in the Centre itself or at an electronic location for non-profit making purposes. The Council, likewise, will reproduce still photographs for the image data bank and for lists and catalogues of works at the public's disposal.

7. Acceptation of obligations

Participation in the current competition implies full acceptance of the rules thereof.

The selected pieces will be presented at the Montehermoso Arts and Culture Centre in June 2006 within the framework of ***Vitoria Territorio Visual***.
